It is the policy of Morson to identify, manage and reduce the environmental, social, and economic impacts associated with our supply chain activities.

We are committed to:

- Setting objectives and action plans in support of this policy and pursuing continual improvement where practicable.
- Ensuring our suppliers have embedded sustainable and ethical practices within their organisation and actively promote these values throughout their own supply chain.
- Defining appropriate risk levels and implementing sufficient controls for suppliers who are of high and critical risk.
- Complying with all applicable legislation and relevant industry standards.

Through supplier selection and ongoing engagement, we will monitor suppliers and the steps they take to reduce their environmental footprint through:

- Carbon management, including the responsible use of energy, water, and materials.
- Waste minimisation within their operations and through the reduction of packaging.
- Reducing the environmental impact of deliveries and logistics activities.

Morson is committed to supporting local and UK wide economic growth by:

- Creating job opportunities and facilitating engagement with small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs) and social businesses.
- Considering the life-cycle cost of products and services in procurement decisions.
- Ensuring that employees and contractors receive, as a minimum, the Living Wage.

This policy supports and should be applied in conjunction with the Procurement, Supplier Qualification and Evaluation Procedure, which defines the framework for assessing, approving, and monitoring suppliers.

This policy will be communicated throughout the Morson Group and made available to all relevant stakeholders.
